Description:

SPSS is a widely used program for statistical analysis in social science. SPSS is a powerful suite of data analytics, reporting and modelling software. It is the data analytics software package of choice for people who need to analyse large amounts of quantitative data and is used as standard by a wide range of users who need to quickly and accurately carry out statistical analysis of that data such as market researchers, health researchers, survey companies, government, education researchers, marketing organizations and data miners.

SPSS functionality ranges from simple plots and charts; to much more sophisticated statistical tests. Although very broadly applicable, SPSS is very well-suited to analysing survey data. It has a very broad range of applications from the relatively simple like calculating frequencies and creating lists and charts to the far more advanced like variance analysis, multivariate statistical analysis, and cluster analysis. It is also useful in building predictive models.
