GENDER SENSITIZATION CELL (GSC)

UGC in its DO letter No. P.91-31201.0.5) has advised all universities to review the existing arrangements for the safety and security of girls & women in particular and of the entire youth in general and has further advised to constitute a committee and a separate cell to deal with issues of gender based violence and gender sensitization programmes to give effect to a policy of zero tolerance on campus for gender based violence and harassment, if any.

A committee already in place needs to be refrained to include terms of reference, as identified below.

The Cell would provide on-going management advice, supervision and oversight, as well as information material from time-to-time. The senior officers/faculty members, including Secretary of college, should keep a close watch to ensure that such incidents do not occur at all.

As approved by the Director. the following committee is constituted. The committee should identify any changes required in our existing system and submit its recommendation to Secretary of college .
